CEEWA-Uganda beneficiaries receive a ground nut huller/sheller from Iganga Rotary Club. Agali awamu Women's Group found in Bulowoza parish Bulamagi Sub county Iganga district was linked by CEEWA-Uganda to Rotary Community Corps (RCC) a project of Rotary Club International through Iganga Rotary Computer Resource Centre a CEEWA-Uganda ICT project collaboration partner. RCC purpose is to promote grassroots self-help projects, maximize local resources, and use appropriate cost-efficient technology.



The group received the equipment on 30-May-2007 at Iganga Rotary Computer Resource Centre and members were trained on how to use the machine. The group is composed of 30 women members who are involved in livestock and crop farming business. The group members grow mainly ground nuts and maize for commercial purposes. They are also involved in zero-grazing of exotic cattle and goats, diversified with poultry, retail shops among others.
